**J.E.A. CRAKE – GEORGE C. LEMMON BURSARY  
FOR GRADUATE STUDIES IN THEOLOGY**

The J.E.A. Crake Foundation, established by the late Dr. J. Ernest A. Crake, Josiah Wood Professor of Classics at Mount Allison University, 1946-1976, supports the Anglican Church, particularly the Parish of Sackville, (St. Ann's and St. Paul's Churches); the Parish of Dorchester and the Parish of Westmorland. Dr. Crake was Treasurer of Sackville Parish and an active Lay Reader who conducted services in every church within these three parishes.

The Foundation offers bursary support for those studying theology for ordination in the Anglican Church in the Diocese of Fredericton.

**Terms And Conditions**

1. The bursary must be held at an institution of higher education which offers a graduate degree in Theology
2. Primary consideration for support will be given to candidates from the Parishes of Sackville, Dorchester and Westmorland.
3. Consideration will also be given to Mount Allison students/graduates planning to work in Anglican Parishes other than the those in the Diocese of Fredericton.

**Procedures**

1. The Foundation will deposit funds to the Diocese made by September 1 for the academic year.
2. Applications for bursaries are made to the Bishop of Fredericton before September 1.
3. The Diocesan Examining Chaplains Committee will make recommendations to the Bishop who will make the final decision by October 31 and notify the applicants and the Foundation.
4. A report must be made by each recipient by May 1 following the announcement of the award. If the term is not finished the bursary holder will provide an interim report by that date, and follow up with a final report by the following May 1, to:
