

Parish of New Bandon

The Bishop of Fredericton seeks to appoint a priest and rector to the Parish of New Bandon in the Diocese of Fredericton.

The two-point Parish of New Bandon runs along the picturesque coast of the Bay of Chaleur following Route 11 eastward from the east boundary of the City of Bathurst, encompassing the communities of Salmon Beach, Janeville, Clifton, Stonehaven and New Bandon (a distance of about 30 kilometers) as well as the communities of Canobie and South Canobie, a few kilometers south of the Janeville/Clifton area.

There are two church buildings: Christ Church in Clifton and St Alban's in Salmon Beach. The parish rectory and Christ Church hall are in Clifton less than a kilometer from Christ Church. Worship services alternate between the two buildings and between the Book of Common Prayer and Book of Alternate Services.

Expressions of interest should include:

- A [Curriculum Vitae](#).
- Three referees prepared to provide information on the cleric's pastoral skills, his or her interpersonal and communication skills, ability to build community, ministry experience and sensitivity. If you are an Assistant Curate or graduating postulant for ordination, you should give your Rector, supervising priest or mentor as a reference.
- A written statement of about 500 words outlining why they are being called to explore this opportunity.

Clergy from outside the diocese should confirm that they have their bishop's permission to explore a possible appointment outside of their own diocese.

A confidential reference may also be requested from your Diocesan Bishop and in addition to other references.

The successful candidate will be required to authorize a criminal record and vulnerable sector check and may be required to authorize a credit check.
