

Parish of Kingston

The Bishop of Fredericton seeks to appoint a priest and rector to the Anglican Parish of Kingston in the Diocese of Fredericton.

The Parish of Kingston is seeking a community-minded priest with a visible spiritual connection, a positive and supportive attitude and leadership qualities. The parish mission statement is: We believe in Jesus Christ and accept him as our Lord and Saviour and endeavour to bring others to this life changing relationship with God.

The parish covers the Kingston Peninsula, located between the St. John and Kennebecasis Rivers. There are four church buildings, but normally there is a single service each Sunday, held at historic Trinity Church in Kingston 9 months of the year and rotating around all the buildings through the spring and summer. A rectory is located beside Trinity. Worship alternates between the BCP and the BAS with music from both Common Praise and Mission Praise.

Expressions of interest should include:

- A [Curriculum Vitae](#).
- Three referees prepared to provide information on the cleric's pastoral skills, his or her interpersonal and communication skills, ability to build community, ministry experience and sensitivity. If you are an Assistant Curate or graduating postulant for ordination, you should give your Rector, supervising priest or mentor as a reference.
- A written statement of about 500 words outlining why they are being called to explore this opportunity.

Clergy from outside the diocese should confirm that they have their bishop's permission to explore a possible appointment outside of their own diocese.

A confidential reference may also be requested from your Diocesan Bishop and in addition to other references.

The successful candidate will be required to provide a valid criminal record and vulnerable sector check and may be required to authorize a credit check.
