

Parish of Campobello

The Bishop of Fredericton seeks to appoint a half-time incumbent (priest-in-charge) to the Anglican Parish of Campobello in the Diocese of Fredericton.

The Parish of Campobello covers the island of Campobello located at the entrance of the Bay of Fundy south of the New Brunswick mainland. There are three communities on the island. Home to both the Roosevelt-Campobello International Park and Herring Cove Provincial Park, it offers over 3000 acres of natural scenery with miles of hiking and biking trails, quiet beaches and bold cliffs.

The parish has a single church building, St. Anne's in Welshpool, built in 1855, as well as a 23-year old rectory. There is normally one worship service per week, on Sunday, as well as the opportunity to lead a service once a month at the nursing home.

The parish is looking for an incumbent with strong spiritual beliefs, who has the ability to motivate with enthusiasm and conviction. They are keen to explore opportunities in the Fresh Expressions area.

Expressions of interest should include:

- A [Curriculum Vitae](#).
- Three referees prepared to provide information on the cleric's pastoral skills, his or her interpersonal and communication skills, ability to build community, ministry experience and sensitivity. If you are an Assistant Curate or graduating postulant for ordination, you should give your Rector, supervising priest or mentor as a reference.
- A written statement of about 500 words outlining why they are being called to explore this opportunity.

Clergy from outside the diocese should confirm that they have their bishop's permission to explore a possible appointment outside of their own diocese.

A confidential reference may also be requested from your Diocesan Bishop and in addition to other references.

The successful candidate will be required to provide a valid criminal record and vulnerable sector check and may be required to authorize a credit check.
