

Parishes of Waterford and St. Mark's (shared ministry)

The Bishop of Fredericton seeks to appoint a priest and rector to the Anglican Parishes of Waterford and St. Mark's in the Diocese of Fredericton.

These neighbouring parishes are located in south central New Brunswick, near the town of Sussex. They have shared an incumbent for many years. There are two church buildings with weekly services, another with a monthly service and a chapel of ease. The combined membership is approx. 250 people.

The people are firm in their belief in the Gospel and endeavour to accommodate traditional and contemporary expressions of faith during worship. They also try to keep apprised of and respond to the needs of the communities in which they are placed.

Expressions of interest should include:

- A [Curriculum Vitae](#).
- Three referees prepared to provide information on the cleric's pastoral skills, his or her interpersonal and communication skills, ability to build community, ministry experience and sensitivity. If you are an Assistant Curate or graduating postulant for ordination, you should give your Rector, supervising priest or mentor as a reference.
- A written statement of about 500 words outlining why they are being called to explore this opportunity.

Clergy from outside the diocese should confirm that they have their bishop's permission to explore a possible appointment outside of their own diocese.

A confidential reference may also be requested from your Diocesan Bishop and in addition to other references.

The successful candidate will be required to provide a valid criminal record and vulnerable sector check and may be required to authorize a credit check.
