

## **Parishes of Hillsborough Riverside, St. Andrew's Sunny Brae and St. Philip's**

The Bishop of Fredericton seeks to appoint an incumbent (full-time priest-in-charge) to a three parish shared ministry in the Moncton, New Brunswick, area.

The parishes of St. Andrew's Sunny Brae and St. Philip's are located in residential areas in the city of Moncton, with a single church building each. The Parish of Hillsborough Riverside includes two church buildings in the rural communities of Hillsborough, on the Petitcodiac River, and Riverside-Albert, on the Bay of Fundy, approximately 30 and 50 minutes' drive, respectively, south of Moncton.

These three parishes have already been in shared ministry, along with a fourth parish, since 2011. There are two active ordained deacons and several layreaders within this parish grouping.

Expressions of interest should include:

- A [Curriculum Vitae](#).
- Three referees prepared to provide information on the cleric's pastoral skills, his or her interpersonal and communication skills, ability to build community, ministry experience and sensitivity. If you are an Assistant Curate or graduating postulant for ordination, you should give your Rector, supervising priest or mentor as a reference.
- A written statement of about 500 words outlining why they are being called to explore this opportunity.

Clergy from outside the diocese should confirm that they have their bishop's permission to explore a possible appointment outside of their own diocese.

A confidential reference may also be requested from your Diocesan Bishop and in addition to other references.

The successful candidate will be required to provide a valid criminal record and vulnerable sector check and may be required to authorize a credit check.
