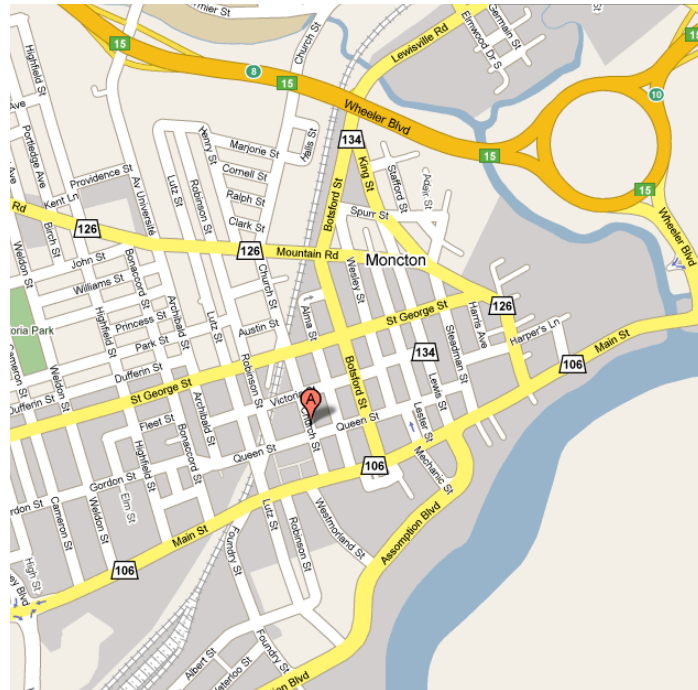
Take Hwy 1 then Hwy2E
