Eric Beresford is the President of Atlantic School of Theology, a position he has held since December 2004. He is a scholar and prolific writer who is widely published in professional journals and sought after as a consultant and speaker at workshops and conferences in the fields of ethics, justice, conflict and change, and human sexuality. Canon Beresford is an ordained Anglican priest who has served parishes in England and Canada and continues to serve on national committees of the Anglican Church of Canada. His research interests include Environmental ethics and justice.

Brian Walsh is an activist theologian and the CRC Campus Minister at the University of Toronto. He is also an professor at Wycliffe College. He engages issues of theology and

culture, and has written and co-authored a number of books including: "Collossians Remixed". His most recent offering is entitled "Beyond Homelessness", which he co-authored with Steven Bouma-Prediger.



GARY THORNE
ON PATRISTICS

Gary Thorne is the University Chaplain of King's College in Halifax. He served as Rector of St. George's Parish in Halifax's inner city for 16 years. He is/was a reservist military chaplain for 18 years. Gary is involved in advocacy work in the inner city by serving on several boards, developing friendships, and walking the streets. He provides opportunities for all King's students to become involved in 'hands on' advocacy work in the Halifax community. He also serves on the Primate's Theological Commission and the Faith, Worship and Ministry Committee. His research interests center around the areas of Patristics, monasticism and the study of expositors of classic Anglican theology.
