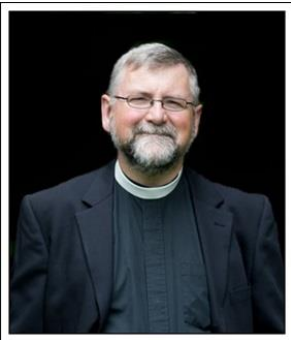

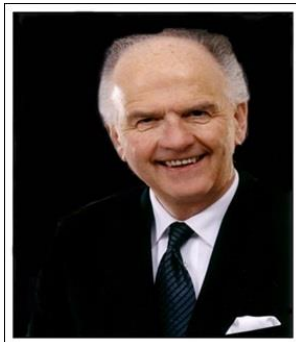

**THE REV'D DR. RANALL  
INGALLS**

A native of New Brunswick, the Rev'd Dr Ranall Ingalls was raised in northern British Columbia. He has studied at Canadian Nazarene College, University of

Winnipeg, University of Manitoba (MA, 1986), Nashotah House & University of Wales, Lampeter (PhD, Theology, 2004). He, Sherry, and three sons, have lived in mostly rural parishes of the kind with which our Province is so richly blessed. At present, Ranall is Rector of Sackville and Dorchester. His course '**Erotic Liturgy: Desire and Common Prayer**' will examine how the tradition of worship we have received opens to us the ancient mystical and sacramental Way of 'the ascents that are in the heart' (St Augustine), offering a way of life that addresses, engages and lifts up twenty-first century anxieties and longings through the Cross of Christ to participation in the life of the Blessed and All-Holy Trinity.

Dr. Laurel Buckingham served as Lead Pastor at Moncton Wesleyan Church ( 1969-2013) He is the founder and CEO of the Buckingham Leadership Institute, a ministry of Kingswood

University, where he has served on the adjunct faculty. Dr. Buckingham graduated from the university in 1961 and has served on the Board of Trustees for over 30 years. The university awarded him the honorary Doctor of Divinity

degree in 1989. He is a leader in the Wesleyan Church, serving on a number of boards and committees. He has hosted the Leadership Village for Willow Creek Canada for 8 years. He the recipient of awards and honours and has published a number of articles. He and Lois reside in Moncton and are the parents of two and grandparents of four. His course, **Dynamic Leadership: Changing Lives** will have an overarching theme of Principles and Plans that Produce. Individual sections will include, Steps to Strength in Leadership, Leadership that Liberates and Necessary Change without Unnecessary Alienation

PAUL FRIESEN**

Dr. Friesen and his family currently reside in Halifax where he serves as rector of St. Paul's Church. A graduate of the University of Toronto, Harvard Divinity

School and he has a PhD. From the University of St. Michael's (Toronto). He has taught at the Atlantic School of Theology and served as a theologian on the Matrimonial Commission of the Anglican Church of Canada. Author of reviews and essays, he has lectured in various places over the past two decades. He has co-authored a number of published works. His current work in progress is Sacramental Religion. Prior to coming to St. Paul's, he served as University Chaplain and Priest in charge of the Chapel at the University of King's College. His course, **Christendom: the role of the 'church' in relation to the 'world'** will take an historical/theological approach to clarify this role, concluding with an evaluation of our present state and what may lie ahead.
