

SACRED STORY, SACRED LAND

The biblical lands at the eastern end of the Mediterranean have been called “the eighth sacrament.” That is, the land itself mediates an encounter with the Holy that is said can be profound and transformative.

Not many, however, have the privilege of walking Jerusalem’s ancient streets, or to read the scriptures by Galilee’s shoreline, or be immersed in the silence of the Judean desert.

In this series Richard LeSueur will lead an exploration of a number of key places in the biblical lands where we will encounter recent archaeology, biblical text and vivid first-hand descriptions of the land in which our Lord’s ministry was first revealed and the gospels took shape. Call it a “virtual pilgrimage” — an encounter with our sacred story and a sacred land.

Canon Dr. Richard LeSueur has served on the teaching staff of St. George’s College, Jerusalem as the Director of the Desert Program. Over the past 25 years he has facilitated more than 40 excursions for clergy and laity into the biblical lands.

He currently serves as the Middle East Liaison for the Anglican Church of Canada, and lives in Canmore, Alberta with his wife, Rhonde.
