

## Diocesan Gift Card

Uses:

- Send to someone who is celebrating an achievement or milestone after you arrange a gift in thanksgiving
- Mark a significant birthday or anniversary by giving a gift and share the news with the honoured individual
- Place it at a funeral home to signify that a gift has been giving in memory of the deceased

## INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions below to create your personalized gift card. This document is composed of two pages. Page 1 – Instructions and Page 2 – The Gift Card.

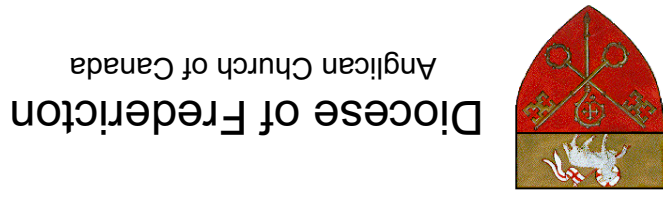
1. Page 2 (the gift card) is arranged in 4 panels, the two panels at the top of the page are purposely upside down to orient them properly for folding the finished card.
2. In the top left panel, the text in the middle field should be modified according to your preference. Place your cursor inside the field and delete or type the changed text.  
“In loving memory” “In Thanksgiving for an Anniversary” “As a Thank Offering” “Remembering a Birthday” etc.
3. The lower right panel has four editable fields. Place your cursor in each field in turn to make changes. The third one is a bold script font and might contain the name of the one honoured or remembered.

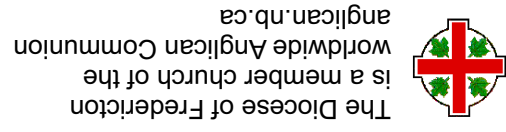
4. The page can be saved to your computer retaining any changes you’ve made. Use it the next time you need a gift card!
5. Right click on the card page (page two) and choose “Print this page” or choose “print” and select page 2 under select pages. You should also make sure “None” is selected under “Page Scaling” to get a full-sized card on your printed page.
6. Print the one page card. Fold top to bottom and left to right to create the finished card.
